- Has Exceptional Case Funding (ECF) been granted?
- Legal Help
- Solicitor concerns Standard Contractual Terms
- Agreement from outset



What can be claimed?

- Exceptional Case Funding (ECF) rates
- Legal Help rates
- Prompt billing
- Payments



AG Fiat Applications

- What are they?
- Can be up to 4 different legal aid rates applicable during proceedings
- Ensure when instructed that funding is clear for each stage

Exceptional Case Funding (ECF) non-inquest

Accepting instructions

- Initial work may be at risk
- Check the public funding certificate
- Ensure you complete billing under the correct legal aid rates



Exceptional Case Funding (ECF) non-inquests

What can be claimed?

- Depends on scope given within the public funding certificate
- Rates applicable will be dependent on scope and in accordance with the usual LAA guidance and <u>The Civil Legal Aid (Remuneration) Regulations 2013</u>
