Description and how to apply

Foundry Chambers is actively recruiting for a third-six pupil. Applications should be made by email to <u>pupillage@foundrychambers.com</u> by 06 March 2021, attaching a CV. Interviews will be conducted by the Pupillage Committee in March. Date of commencement is flexible, and we encourage applications from those who are awaiting a decision from their present chambers, as well as those who have had an adverse decision or decided not to accept an offer.

Third-six pupils will be assigned two pupil supervisors during their time with us, changing supervisor at the three-month stage. You can expect to be in court every day (either in-person or virtually), conducting prosecution and defence work in the Crown Court and magistrates' courts. You will also be given the opportunity to do work for other members of Chambers, and will be invited to attend pupils' advocacy training alongside our 12-month pupils.

As a general rule, we will consider an application for tenancy after a third-six pupil has been in Chambers with us for six months. We have a strong record of recruitment from third-six pupils, and have tenants at all levels of seniority who joined us by this route.
