Description and how to apply

1 Chancery Lane is looking for up to two probationary tenants who wish to practice in civil common law. We are a friendly, medium-sized set with specialisms across a range of work, including personal injury, travel law, clinical and professional negligence, public sector liability, police law and property law. Chambers has recruited extensively from probationary tenants in the past.

During your period as a probationary tenant, you can expect to be given work of different kinds of the type performed by the junior tenants in chambers. This will include case management conferences, applications, trials on the small claims track and fast track (typically in the areas of road traffic accidents and personal injury, but also others). You will also be given paperwork, which will include fixed fee Advices (such as for infant approval hearings), conditional fee cases and possibly fixed fee work for the NHS.
